CHECK-IN

Upon arrival on Friday (1:00 - 7:00 p.m.), please check in at the hospitality area located in The Hub at Emett Student Center. There you will receive a welcome bag containing the specifics of the fun-filled adventure on which you are about to embark.

If you registered for the Class Dinner Only, please arrive at Flamson Plaza by 5:45 p.m. to ensure you're in time for the Class Photo and Toast on Saturday evening.

CMC POP-UP SHOP

ACCOMODATIONS

All participants will be placed in Green or Philips Hall. You will receive your room key when you check-in. Basic motel necessities (sheets, quilt, pillow, towel, etc.) will be provided. However, if you have any other needs such as shampoo, toiletries, bathrobes, slippers, extra soft towels, etc., we recommend that you bring them with you.

ATTIRE

GETTING TO CAMPUS

From I-10 East or West: Exit at Monte Vista and go north. Continue to Arrow Highway and turn left. Turn right at Claremont Blvd. and then left at Sixth or Ninth Street.

From CA-210 East or West: Exit at Baseline and go west. Turn left (south) at Monte Vista. Turn right at Claremont Blvd. Continue south past Foothill and turn right at Sixth or Ninth Street.

PARKING

Parking on campus will be permitted in all areas (except for red zones). Keep in mind that overnight parking is

not permitted on city streets. Please be sure not to leave valuables in your car.
