A Short History of Claremont: Boom, Bust, Colleges, Oranges, and Pilgrims

Located at the foothills of the San Gabriel Mountains, Claremont was originally established in 1887 by the Pacific Land Improvement Company, land developers from Boston who were expecting a population boom along the extended Santa Fe Railroad line. In advance of the crowds, a grand hotel was built in anticipation of crowds that would never come.

The Eastern boys had badly mistimed their investment in the California boom. By 1888, the project was abandoned and the Hotel Claremont given to Pomona University to serve as the centerpiece of a new campus. Pomona was established to be an institution in the "New England style"—and the style of the town that grew up around it and the other Claremont Colleges
